SENIOR SERVICES & HOUSING

Victory Housing | 341 housing units for seniors:

- **Victory Crossing** | 1090 Milestone Dr., Silver Spring (95 of 105 apartments are reserved for affordable housing)
- **Victory Oaks** | 721 Beacon Rd., Silver Spring (49 apartments)
- **Victory Tower** | 7051 Carroll Ave., Takoma Park (187 apartments)

WORKFORCE HOUSING

Victory Housing

79 units of affordable housing for individuals and families:

- **Cambridge Apartments** | 676 Houston Ave., Takoma Park
33 units; 16 minimum are for households at or below 60% of area median income
- **Winslow House** | 666 Houston Ave., Takoma Park
46 units; 23 minimum are for 60% or lower median income

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Washington has a wide range of programs for residents, including

- **Catholic Charities Center** serves all of Montgomery County: Case management, crisis intervention and referral, food pantry and mobile produce distribution, clothing/diapers, parent education, financial education, rent/mortgage/utility assistance and more
- **Community Companions** | Child care for children with disabilities: after-school, in-home support, caregiver respite, camps
- **Community Options**
Engaging and safe environment for persons with disabilities, including nursing, therapies, community integration and activities
- **Employment Programs for Adults with Disabilities**
Support for adults with developmental disabilities to enter the workforce
- **Family Peace** | Trains archdiocesan first responders to recognize the symptoms of domestic violence, respond with compassion and refer survivors to assistance
- **Immigration Services** | Pro bono legal services, Newcomer Network, employment training and assistance and English as a second language
- **Legal Network** | Pro bono legal services addressing debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills and probate, guardianship and conservatorship
- **Parish Partners Program**
Connects Catholic parishes assisting local families with Catholic Charities' expertise and services; county emergency service guide

- **Strong Families Initiative**

Provides Latino youth an outlet to discuss hardships they are facing, to be better equipped to face future difficulties

- **Trafficking Victims Assistance Program**

Comprehensive and strength-based services for children and adult survivors of human trafficking
